

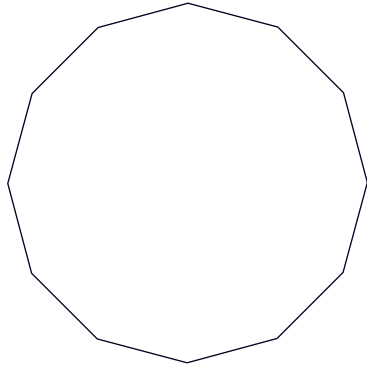
# Look, cover, draw, check

Look at each coin, cover it up and try and draw it from memory. There is space for the obverse and reverse (heads and tails) side of each coin.

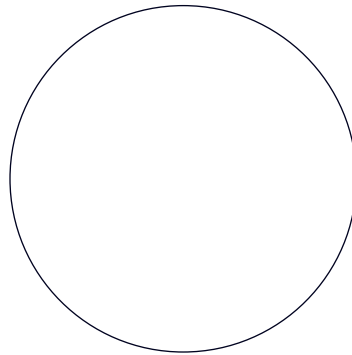

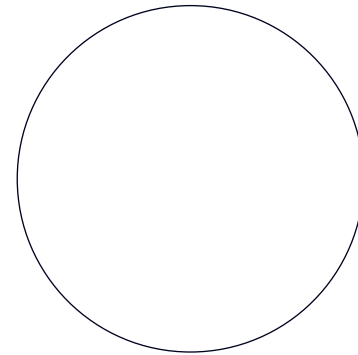
**Fifty cent coin –  
obverse (heads)**



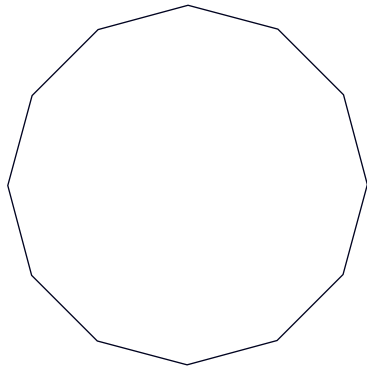
**One dollar coin –  
obverse (heads)**



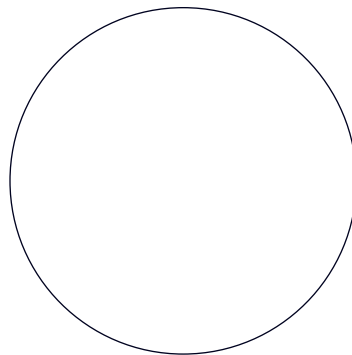
**Two dollar coin –
