2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games Medals

These medals are 63mm in diameter and are made of bronze or silver with gold-plating applied to the first place medal.



2018 INAS Games Medals

These medals are 63mm in diameter and are made of copper. Gold-plating was applied to first place medal, silver-plating to the second place medal and an antiqued finish applied to the third place medal.



Australian Academy of Science Medallions

These medallions are 63mm in diameter and are made of copper antique.



Prime Minister's Prize Medallions

These medallions are 63mm in diameter and are made of solid silver. Over the years these medallions have included a variety of finishes including gold-plating, frosting and colour printing.

Our Process.



Design

The minting process begins with an initial design brief. The Mint can work with your finished art or you can consult with our world-class award winning designers to develop and prepare a bespoke creation. Once the design is approved, a three-dimensional model is sculpted using either traditional plaster modelling with tools, or 3D modelling software. Our coin designers will refine the finest details to ensure your design can be manufactured to the highest quality.



Dies

Your design will be cut directly into a steel tool using a computer-controlled engraving machine. In a process known as hobbing, the design is transferred onto a softened steel block, using 100 to 400 tonnes of pressure. The result is a working hob, containing a positive impression of the design. A manufactured production die, which has a negative impression of the design is then used to strike blanks, turning them into medals, medallions and tokens.



Coining

Made in presses which strike 180-360 tonnes of pressure the blank medals, medallions or tokens are struck 4-6 times each to prepare your special piece. Each piece is then individually inspected using eyeglasses and magnifying lamps to check for any flaws. Additional treatments can then be applied to transfer a high level of detail to the finished piece.



Packaging and Delivery

To deliver medals, medallions or tokens of the highest quality the Mint has a range of packaging available to complete your experience including cases, cards, wall plaques and printed presentation options.

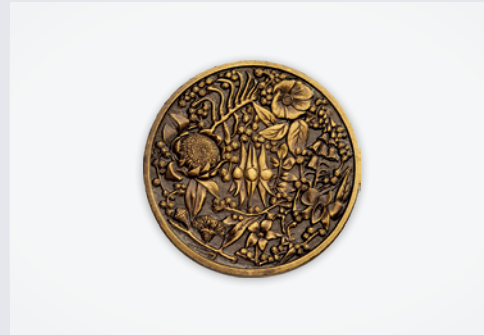

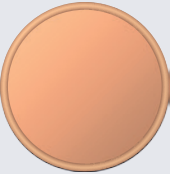
