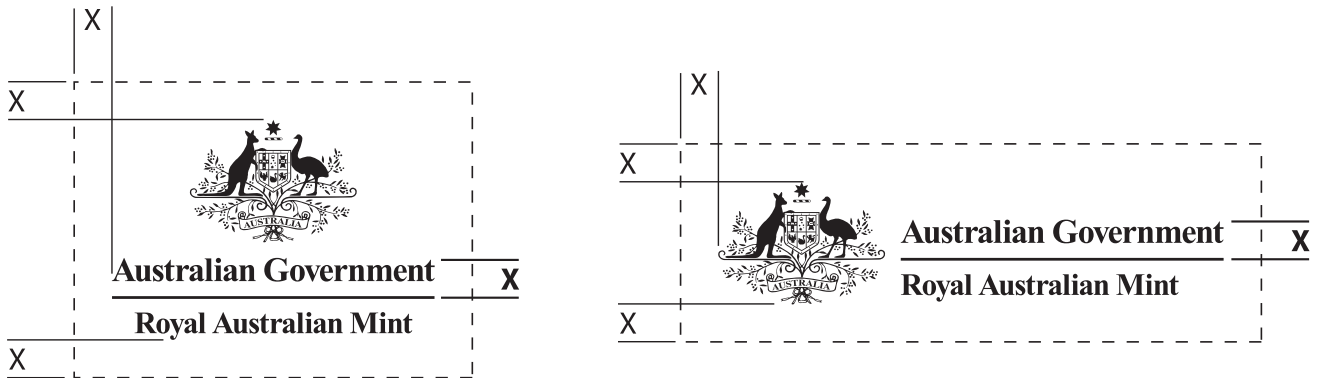


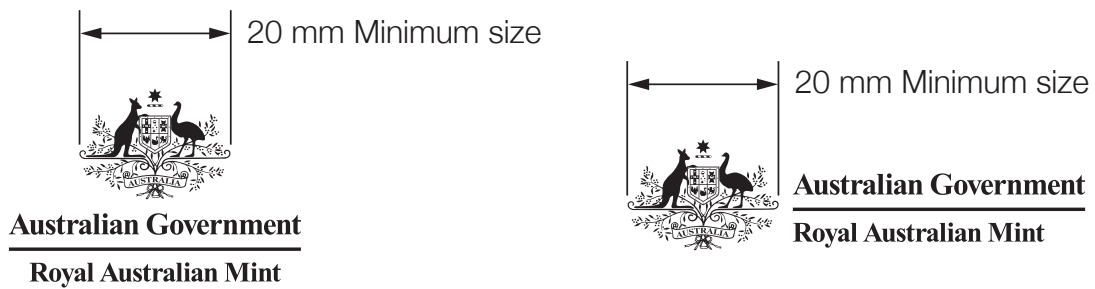
Application – Positioning and Isolation Area

The Logo Design should always have prominence over and above other images and graphic elements. Where possible, the Design should be placed at the top of the item it appears on. An Isolation Area has been established to ensure that the dignity of the Design is not jeopardised through crowding. This zone is defined as 'X' and is based upon the distance between the top of the capital 'A' in 'Australian Government' and the bottom of the horizontal line beneath these words – see diagram below. Please note: this area should be seen as a minimum dimension, and it applies to every form of the Design, and every application of the Design.



Application - Size Requirements

To ensure quality print reproduction the Logo Design must not be printed smaller than shown in the diagram below.



In situations where insufficient space is available to maintain minimum acceptable Logo Design size and Isolation Area the Royal Australian Mint has been given authorisation to use the logo shown in the diagram below.
